

RULES FOR FOG DRIVING CONTEST

The spirit of the contest is to encourage driving original 356's, with the attendant joys and risks of driving a 40+ year old car.

1. **Vehicle** – The vehicle/body must be a 356 manufactured by Porsche with a chassis number listed as being manufactured 1948 through 1965. The engine can be any Porsche or non-Porsche engine.
2. **Driving rules for owners of one 356.** All miles count that are driven by the owner or his/her immediate family (spouse, children). Miles driven by others are not counted.
3. **Driving rules for owners of more than one 356.** All miles count that are driven by the member or his/her immediate family regardless of which 356 he/she is driving. The reported miles are the sum of the miles driven by the multiple vehicles. "Double" miles do not count where more than one vehicle is driven on the same trip by different family members. In that case only the miles driven on one of the vehicles can be counted and the miles put on the other vehicle must be subtracted from the miles on that vehicle. Miles driven on any vehicle by other than family members do not count.
4. **All reporting is on the honor system.**
